Many students and teachers benefited from the camp and they gained valuable insights into eye care and protection.

The camp was well-attended, with the Vice Principal, teachers, and students from Class 1 to 9 participating in the session. The students were made aware of the importance of taking care of their eyes and the potential risks associated with prolonged screen time. As part of the camp, Dr. Sathya offered up to 50% concession for laser eye operations, providing an opportunity for students and teachers to access necessary treatment at a reduced cost.
