LINGUAL FUSION DAY

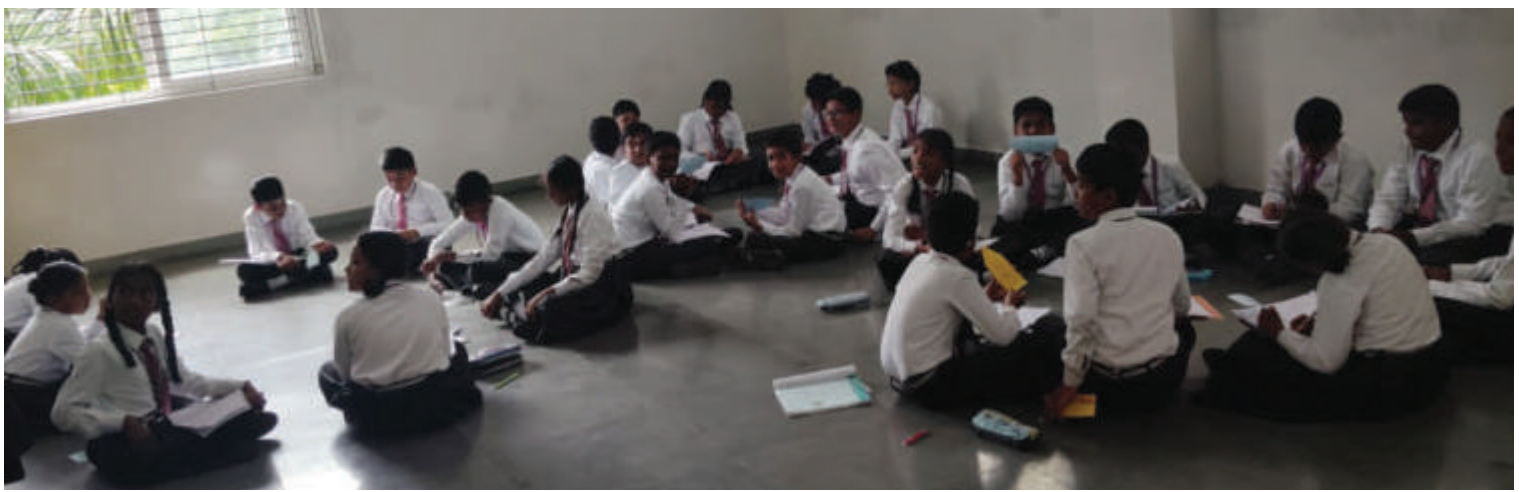
GRADES 3, 4 AND 5
